

# **WCMS Wall of Fame Selection Criteria**

The WCMS Wall of Fame is designed to recognize the contributions and achievements of Warren County Middle School's most influential staff members since the year 1994. Our goal is for the Wall of Fame nominee's to be remembered and rewarded for the outstanding contributions that they made to the overall growth and development of each student they encountered at WCMS.

1. In order to qualify as a candidate for the Wall of Fame, the individual must have been an employee of Warren County Middle School. An employee is defined as any administrator, certified staff (educator) or classified staff (aide, custodian, secretary, cook, etc.)
2. The nominee must have worked at least 10 years for WCMS to be eligible. A unanimous vote of the entire selection committee can over-ride the length of employment requirement
3. The nominee must have been retired for a minimum of 5 years.
4. The nominee will have exhibited good citizenship, high moral character, and was well respected by students, staff and parents.
5. The nominee made a significant positive impact on student learning and served as an excellent role model to their students.
6. There will be a limit of 3 individuals selected for this award each year. In the 2019 inaugural year, 5 individuals will be selected for the Wall of Fame.
7. Each W.O.F. recipient will receive a personal plaque and have a 2<sup>nd</sup> plaque added to the Wall of Fame in their honor. If the recipient is deceased, the 2<sup>nd</sup> plaque will be given to a family member.
8. The WCMS Team Leader committee (16 members) will serve as the selection committee and will make its selection at the May Team Leader meeting.
9. A nomination shall consist of a completed nomination form available upon request from the WCMS front desk or from the WCMS website at [wcms.warrenschools.com](http://wcms.warrenschools.com)
10. Nominations that are not chosen will be left on file each year for future consideration to the Wall of Fame.
11. A nominee must receive at least two-thirds vote from the entire selection committee to be honored. In the event more than the number of eligible receive the two-thirds vote, each selection committee member will rank those receiving the two-thirds vote, with number "1" being their top nominee. The nominee's with the lowest numerical score will be the one(s) honored on the Wall of Fame.
